Responsibilities of the Interim Government

We, Generation Z, claiming the success of the movement that we have been leading since 23-25 Bhadra 2082, supported by all Nepali citizens, against the rampant corruption, lack of transparency, accountability of our public officials and institutions and for rule of law,

Acknowledging that a transparent, uncorrupt and competent Interim Government needs to be formed to make our demands a reality,

Reaffirming the urgency to end poverty, marginalization, and economic exploitation institutionalized by socio-political structural failures,

Strongly supporting Former Chief Justice Sushila Karki as the Prime Minister of the Interim Government of Nepal,

Accepting the decision of the President to dissolve the House of Representatives of Nepal,

Emphasising that a national inclusive dialogue is now necessary to create a sustainable and stable Government,

Recognising the achievements of the People's Movement in ensuring the principles of secularism, federalism, equality, social justice, inclusion, republicanism, and fundamental rights as the constitutional norms.

Condemning the politicisation of all public institutions,

Strongly urge the Interim Government to ascertain that the following broad demands of the Generation Z movement will be fulfilled in good faith:

- Declare the citizens killed in the protest of 23-25 Bhadra 2082 as martyrs and make provisions to address the long term reparative needs of the victims of the Gen Z movement, and their families.
- 2. Launch immediate and independent investigations of all human rights violations committed by the State during the protests from 23-25 Bhadra 2082, and provide security to genuine protesters.
- 3. Ensure that the Cabinet that is to be formed by the Interim Prime Minister respects the principles of inclusion and proportional representation with a woman or gender minority representative, Dalit representative, Indigenous representative, Madheshi representative, representative with disability and representative from disadvantaged regions, supported by an expert advisory group including Gen-Z youth.
- 4. Secure the rights of specifically the Gen-Z to participate in the upcoming election processes, while ensuring fair and transparent elections.
- 5. Form an impartial, independent and competent commission to fast track investigations and prosecutions of corrupt officials and party members.

- 6. End all corruption and abuse of power and authority by reforming federal, provincial, and local institutions and political parties.
- 7. Ensure that the first mandate of the parliament to be elected is to ensure a direct election for the Head of Government, limited to a two-term mandate.
- 8. Ensure that all decisions and actions taken by the Interim Cabinet will be duly and transparently communicated to the public.
